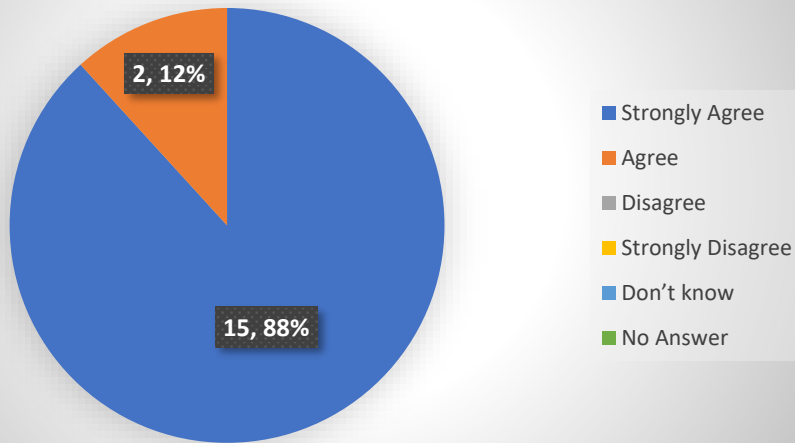
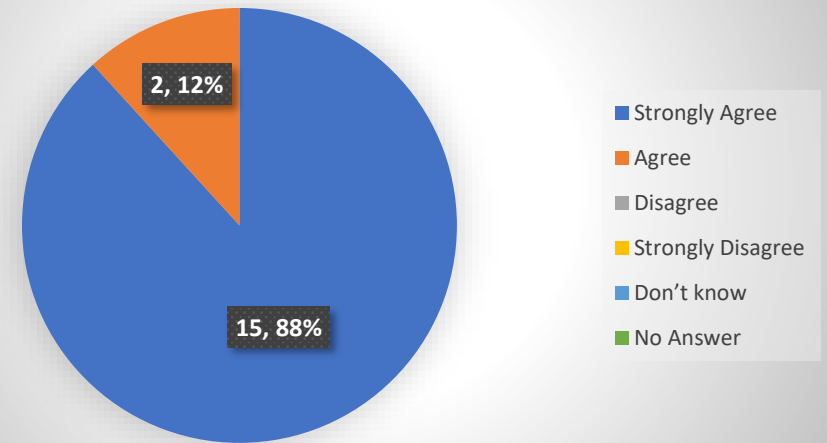

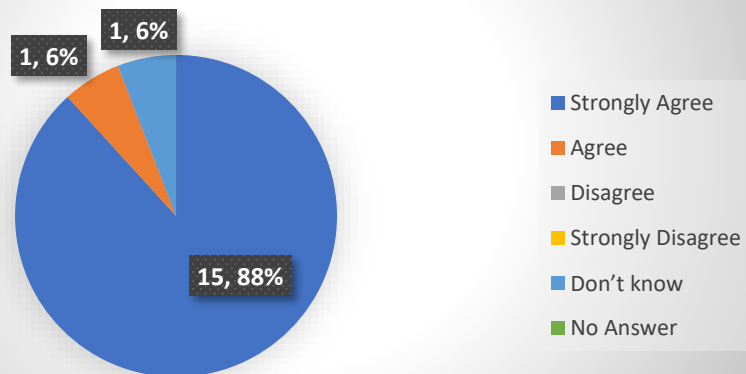
**1. My child is happy at school**



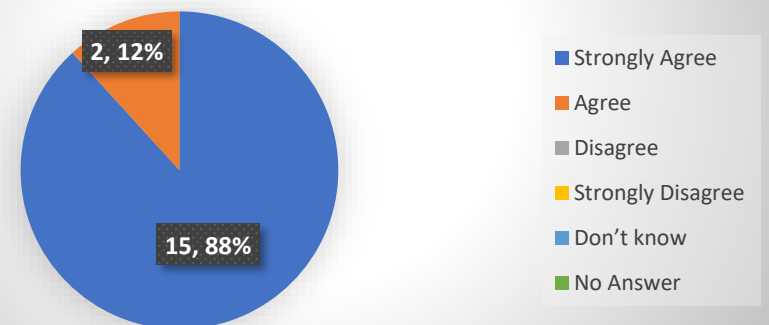
**2. My child feels safe at this school**

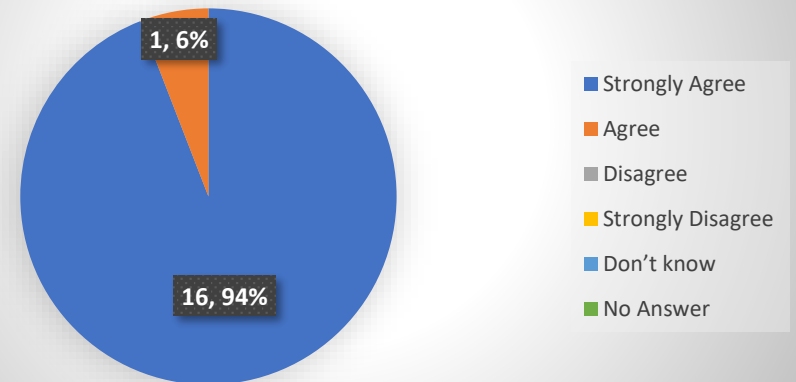

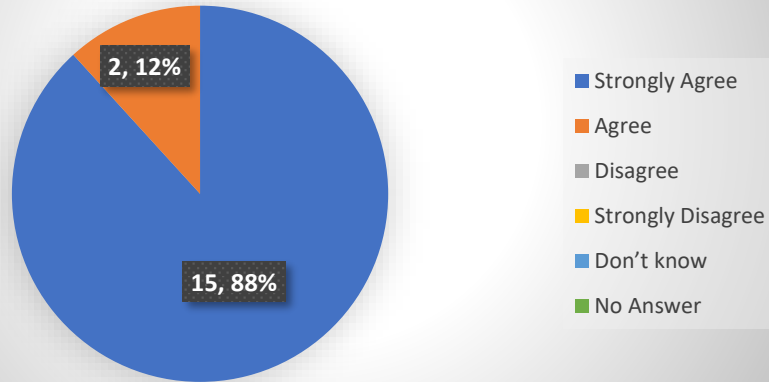

### Examples of parent comments

#### **What are you pleased about in relation to school?**

- There are too many things to list them all! The whole philosophy of the school is one in which every child is treated as an individual with their unique set of attributes. It is clearly evident from the calibre of staff at the school that a high standard is expected. In June 2019, PECS was introduced to our daughter. This was the exact right time for her, and she picked it up quickly. This has led her to being able to communicate her wants and needs more easily.
