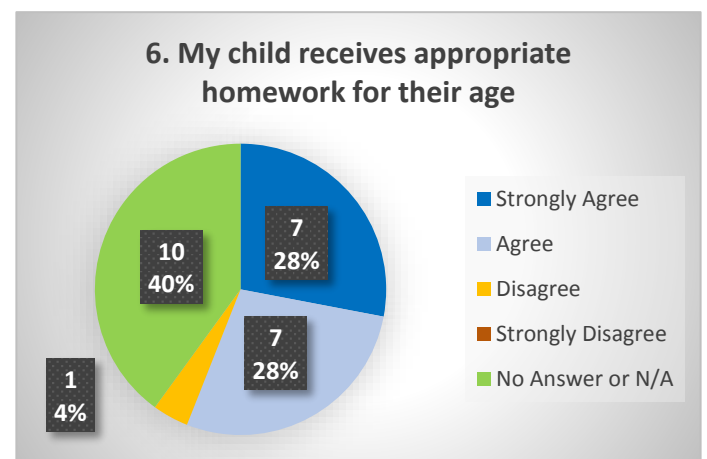
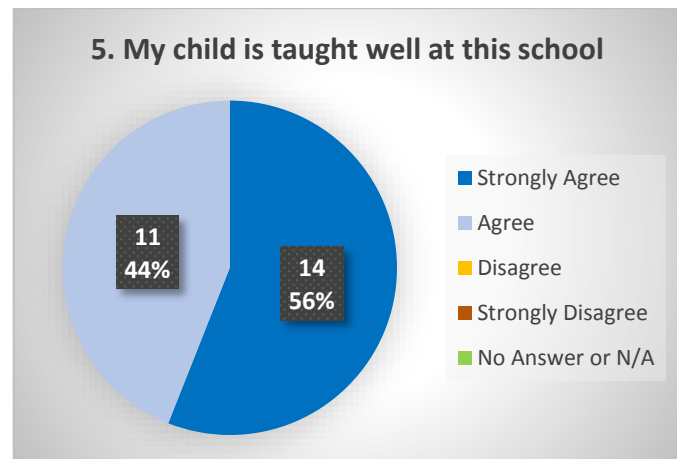
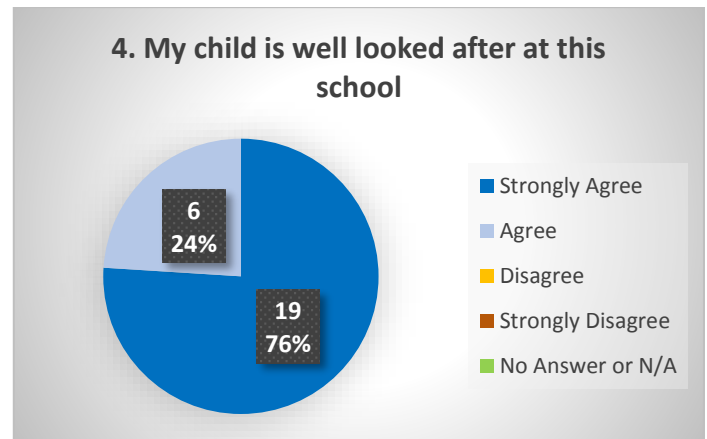
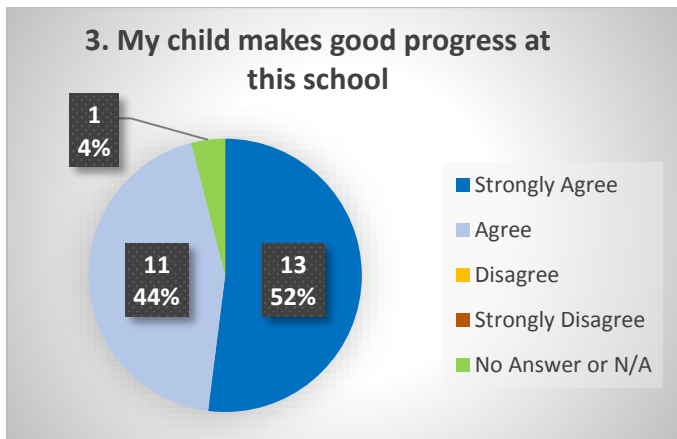
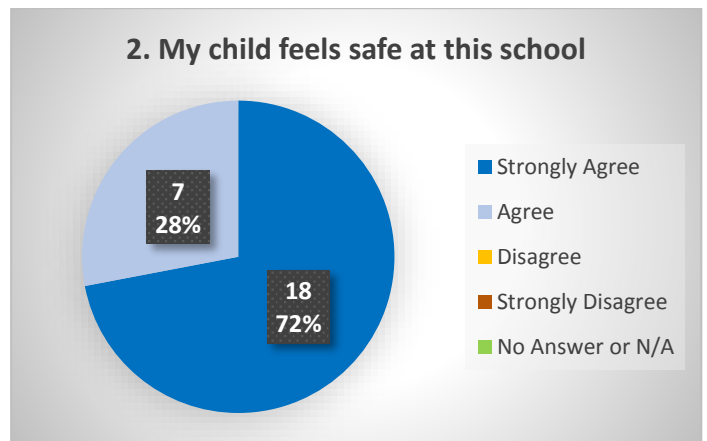
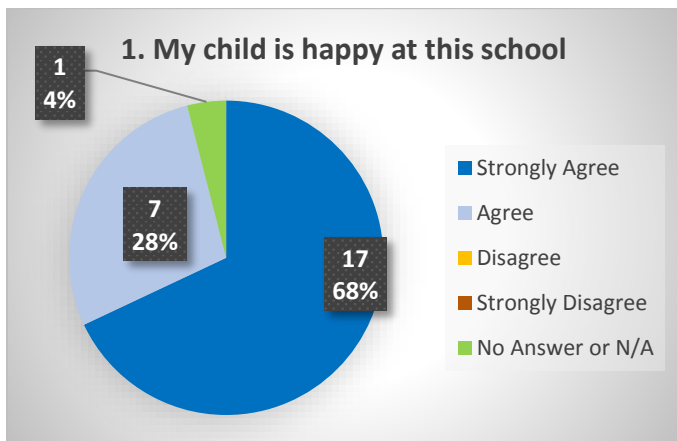


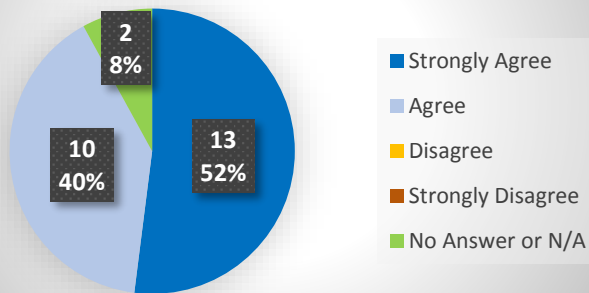
Dear parent/carers,

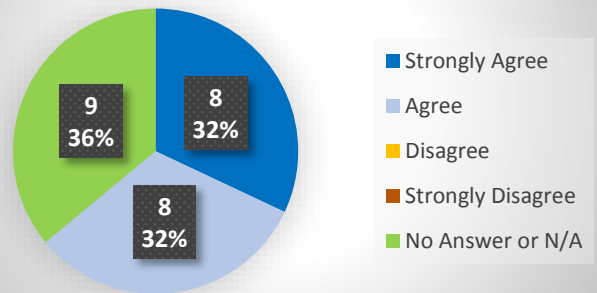

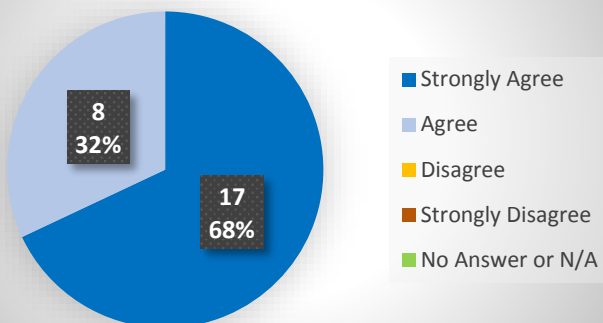

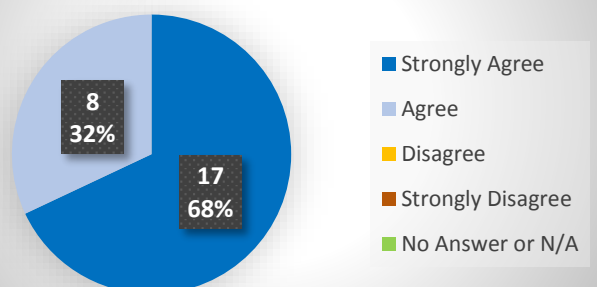
8. The school deals with any cases of bullying effectively



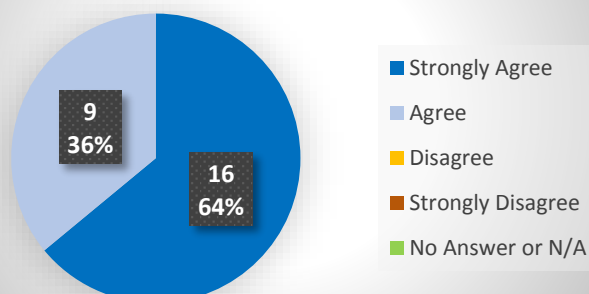

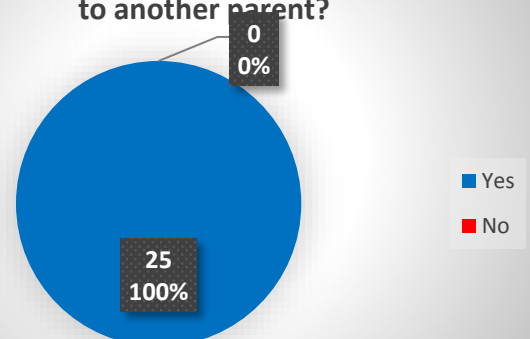
