

Class teams will be planning lots of exciting activities linked to the following special events. Information will be provided via the home school diary.







If you have any worries or concerns about your child please do not hesitate to let us know. We want to work with you to support them.


### Did you know?!

Did you know that Makaton and PECS shopping lists are now available at Asda? Simply ask at the Customer Services desk.




### Reminders
