

We would like to offer a warm welcome to the children and families who have joined the EYFS Phase this term! We hope you are all well and looking forward to your child starting school with us.


We can imagine that as parents and carers you may well be apprehensive, so we would like to reassure you that our priority will be safety and to support your child to settle in to school.

We would like to say a big hello and welcome to the children who are joining the Bridge school full time this term.




The focus of this year is **All about me!**

Over the year we will look at many aspects to this theme beginning with:




My Body and Senses




Photograph request!


